

Easy Peasy Scarf



MATERIALS

Stylecraft Double Knit Batik Yarn 50g (4 balls)

You will also need 1 pair of 4mm circular needles and 1 pair of 4mm needles

MEASUREMENTS

	One Size
Width	20cm
Length	175cm

TENSION

22 stitches, 30 rows to 10 cm

ABBREVIATION

cm centimeters, **co** cast on, **cont** continue, **DK** double knitting, **g.st.** garter stitch, **in** inches, **k** knit, **rep** repeat, **st(s)** stitches, **st st** stocking stitch, **p** purl, **tog** together, **ws** wrong side

SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

BEGINNING OF SCARF

Cast on 50st

Row 1 : K row

Row 2 : P row

Row 3 : K row

Row 4 : P row

MAIN PATTERN

Row 1 : K4, (P2, K2) Repeat 21 times, K4

Row 2 : K4 (K2, P2) Repeat 21 times, K4

Row 3 : K row

Row 4 : P Row

Continue with above 4 rows, until scarf measures 175 cm or desired length.

FINISH SCARF

Row 1 : K row

Row 2 : K row.

SCARF FRINGE

Cut the yarn into the required number of equal lengths. Each fringe has 2 strands of yarn and you want to add fringe to every 2nd st, therefore you need 50 lengths of yarn for each side – 100 in total.

Take your hook and draw the loop through the stitch that you attaching the fringe to. Draw the loose ends of the yarn through the loop, pull gently on the fringe end to secure the fringe.
